



ETS Seminar here

The McNair army Education Center will offer a Pre Separation Seminar on January 21-22, 1982 from 1-4 pm. All participants must be within 90 days of ETS and have completed their 5-6 month unit reenlistment interview. Service members wishing to participate should request permission from their unit and then reserve a place in the seminar by informing the education Center of their intention to attend. Participants will be limited to 20.

The seminar content will be designed to fulfill the needs of the participants, and may include some or all of the following: Cutprocessing in USAREUR and CONUS, DD 214, unemployment compensation, re-employment rights, job finding, life insurance, medical disability, GI Bill and home loan benefits, VEAP, education loans, goal setting, discussion of assertion vs. aggression, resume writing and job interview techniques/role playing.

Attendance will be kept during the seminar and reported to supervisory personnel upon request. Supervisors are encouraged to allow service members to participate if duty requirements will allow it.

Pre Separation Seminars will be offered

on a quarterly basis, so if you have more than 90 days before your ETS, you will have an opportunity to participate next quarter.

Renovation of the Hoechst Child Care Center is schedule to be completed this month and will provide a safe, healthy environment for children of Brigade soldiers.

The repairs, costing 35,500 marks, included knocking out walls to enlarge the facility, new toilet, sinks, a waterheater and a paint job according to Carla Stark, a child care attendant at the center.

The center located in the Hoechst Housing area, building 2436, can accommodate children between the ages of six weeks to 12 years old Monday thru Fridays from 630 am to 530 pm.

During the day the children have a music program, story time, crafts, free play and other activities.

The rates are 80 cents per hour or \$37.50 a week for the entire 55 hours.
