On February 7, 8, 9th, there will be a Non-combatant Evacuation Order (NEO) exercise conducted throughout the Frankfurt Military Community. All personnel living in the Hoechst Housing Area and all personnel assigned to McNair with dependents should insure that their NEO kits are complete.
