## German Sports Award is a challenge

All around athletes of the 22nd Signal Brigade have an unique opportunity to qualify for the Deutsches Sportabzeichen (German Sports Award) for men and women. This civilian award is sponsored by the Deutscher Sportbund (German Sports Federation).

The sports award is part of a continuous year-round program sponsored by the Deutscher Sportbund for individuals eight years old and older. The adult program is divided into age groups for men and women.

Each individual selects the five events he or she desires to compete in. Group I has the 200 meter swim; Group II has the high and long jump; Group III is

a sprint/run.; Group IV is a strength category (shotput, weight lifting, with optional 100 meter swim); and Group V is long distance testing with an individual's choice of running, cycling, swimming or cross country skiing.

All individuals must pass one event from each group and have one year to pass all five events. A failure in any event requires a wait until the next calendar year before starting testing again.
